

ARTIST STATEMENT

Adriana Artmeier is an emerging, Melbourne based artist, focusing on realism mixed with some surrealistic and pop-art elements. Adriana is originally from Germany, with Italian and Slovenian roots and moved to Australia in 2016 after graduating from the Municipal Technical School of Design in Munich.

The majority of her work is inspired by the underwater world, marine life conservation and occurring challenges in today's society.
